MAGS Users' Advisory Group

- Invitation extended to people in water management field: govt, water boards, hydro utilities, mining/petroleum industry
- Attended science conferences/AGMs to observe current research activities & updates
- Question posed: How can GEWEX-MAGS help water management professionals?

MAGS Users Advisory Group

- Response: Global Scale is good stuff:
- but, we need hydrology on small basins, with scale on 10s km², 100s km², and 1000s km²
 - Mine site water balance
 - Highway and pipeline stream crossings
 - Hydro-electricity: assessment, development, operations, flow forecasts



MAGS Users Advisory Group

- User needs:
- Larger scale >10,000 km²
 - Hydro-electricity operations, etc
 - Transboundary flow scenarios for withdrawals, transfers, climate change
 - Ice jam/flood forecasting
 - Forecasts for river transportation



- PUB Workshop
 - Yellowknife, March 2004
- IP3 in Cold Regions Network
 - Follow-up to GEWEX, but regional vs global
 - Shorter term, 4 year mandate
 - Hydrological Basins with real winters
